



REJECTION OF COVERAGE

Louisiana law allows sole proprietors, partners and bona fide executive officers of a corporation, each owning not less than ten (10%) percent of the stock therein to reject workers' compensation for themselves.

EACH SOLE PROPRIETOR, PARTNER, OR SUCH EXECUTIVE OFFICER MUST SIGN FOR REJECTION OF COVERAGE BELOW
